Region 5's Gero Community Stabilization Team

The purpose of the Gero Community Stabilization Program is to stabilize the geriatric population at jeopardy of losing their current community living situation due to behaviors that places them at risk of being hospitalized and prevent them from a state level psychiatric hospitalization. This program makes it possible to discharge older adults from the hospital to their home or nursing homes and assisted living facilities by serving as a step-down service that provides crisis stabilization and intensive mental health services.
